Description (max 200 words)	<p>This is an initiative to provide a method with activities to learn Spanish language for children from 6 to 9 years of age with knowledge of the language.</p> <p>These activities aim, on the one hand, to provide alternatives to the usual proposals included in the manuals and to come out of what is always done; and secondly, to provide a sequence of work, with several steps, for those without much experience in this field.</p>
Methodology (max 150 words)	<p>The proposed activities, are downloadable and printable as individual cards and may be used both in mainstream classes (all children) and also tutoring (1-1).</p> <p>All communication skills are taught: oral and written expression (very basic); listening and reading (images and very simple texts).</p>
